BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Building-Related and Fire Codes Appeals Advisory Board is comprised of 17 primary members and 17 alternate members that are appointed at-large by the City Council based on the nominations received. Nominations of primary and alternate members for each category are provided by Industry Associations that are affiliated with nationally recognized organizations.

The Board hears and decides on appeals of orders, decisions, or determinations made by the Building Official or the Fire Chief relative to the applications and interpretations of Chapter 10, Chapter 11, and specific Articles in Chapter 28 of the City Code. They shall advise the Building Official or Fire Chief on code-related matters upon request.

ISSUE:

Board appointments require full City Council approval.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Office of the City Clerk recommends approval of the Council Committee's recommendation and that said item be forwarded for approval by the full City Council at the April 4, 2019 Meeting.
