ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH PROFESSIONAL TURF PRODUCTS TO PROVIDE SEVEN REPLACEMENT MOWERS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$68,558.77 FOR THE TRANSPORTATION & CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENTS. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FROM THE FY 2019 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Professional Turf Products, through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the "Buyboard"), to provide the City with seven replacement zero turn mowers for a total cost of \$68,558.77; and

WHEREAS, these mowers will be used for right-of-way easement mowing and park lawn maintenance throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Professional Turf Products to provide the City with seven replacement zero turn mowers for a total cost of \$68,558.77 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount up to \$68,558.77 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget.

SECTION 3. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Professional Turf Products to provide six replacement mowers for the Transportation & Capital Improvements Department and one replacement mower for the Parks & Recreation Department, and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project

Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
