Background

- Animal Care Services (ACS) impounds an average of 30,000 animals per year
- ACS has maintained a live release rate of over 90% for the last two fiscal years
- In FY 18, ACS partners rescued 12,405 animals
- Large partners include:
 - San Antonio Humane Society
 - San Antonio Pets Alive!
 - Animal Defense League

Background


- Paul Jolly Center was built in FY 2012
- City has leased the facility to two operators thru a competitive solicitation process since FY 2013
- Current operator is Animal Defense League, 3 year lease contract ends on October 31, 2019



Project & Solicitation Overview

ACS is seeking to lease the Paul Jolly Center for Pet Adoptions to a nonprofit organization to operate the adoption center and the Petco Pavilion. The selected tenant will be responsible for:

- Operation and management of the facility
- Rescuing 2,500 animals from ACS per year and maintaining 90% live release rate
- Providing veterinary care for rescued animals
- Providing educational opportunities for the community through the use of the Petco Pavilion.
