ORDINANCE 2019-04-11-0302

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID WITH ONE ADDITIVE ALTERNATE AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO JERDON ENTERPRISE, L.P. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,698,757.64 FOR THE BUENA VISTA CORRIDOR (FRIO STREET TO SANTA ROSA STREET) PROJECT, A 2012-2017 BOND FUNDED PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICTS 1 AND 5.

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WHEREAS, the Buena Vista Corridor Project is a \$2,500,000.00 2012-2017 General Obligation Bond funded Project to provide for improvements to the Buena Vista Corridor along Frio Street to Santa Rosa Street; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance awards a construction contract for improvements to the Buena Vista Corridor to include widening of a sidewalk under the IH-35 underpass, sidewalk extensions at Old Concho Street, the addition of paver sidewalks, a High-Intensity Activated Crosswalk signal at Leona Street, upgrades to existing traffic signals to meet American with Disabilities Act requirements and pedestrian lighting and landscape improvements east of Pecos La Trinidad; and

WHEREAS, the City received and opened three (3) bids in February 2018; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid with one additive alternate submitted by Jerdon Enterprise, L.P. in an amount not to exceed \$1,698,757.64 for the Buena Vista Corridor Project; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid with one additive alternate by Jerdon Enterprise, L.P. in an amount not to exceed \$1,698,757.64 for the Buena Vista Corridor (Frio Street to Santa Rosa Street) Project, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.

SECTION 2. Payment not to exceed \$1,698,757.64 in SAP Fund 45099000, General Obligation Capital Projects, SAP Project Definition 40-00291, Buena Vista Corridor, is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Jerdon Enterprise, L.P., to provide construction services.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


