The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval to install a memorial plaque in Olmos Basin Park located at 651 Devine Rd.

## APPLICABLE CITATIONS:

Sec. 35-645. - Signs and Billboards on Public Property or Right-of-Way.
(a) General Provisions. All non-regulatory signage on public property, on the public right-of-way, or overhanging the public right-of-way shall conform to all city codes and must be approved by the historic preservation officer prior to installation. Permits must be obtained following approval of the application. The historic preservation officer may submit an application under this section to the historic and design review commission for their recommendation prior to approving, denying, or approving with conditions the application. Memorials, markers, naming rights of public property, and recognition of charitable donations given to the City of San Antonio shall be additionally governed by existing policies for memorials and markers and/or any formal action passed by city council. Temporary displays approved by the department exercising control of the public property are authorized if in accordance with chapter 28 of the City Code of San Antonio, Texas.

## FINDINGS:

a. The location of 651 Devine Rd is the site of Olmos Basin Park, which is a city-owned, multipurpose park located north of downtown and east of the City of Olmos Park. The applicant is requesting approval to install a commemorative plaque along a pedestrian trail just west of Dick Friedrich Dr and east of US Hwy 281.
b. PLAQUE - The applicant is requesting approval to install a freestanding cast aluminum plaque. The plaque will be affixed to a small limestone boulder to measure approximately $2^{\prime}$ to $2.5^{\prime}$ tall and 3 to $3.5^{\prime}$ wide. The plaque will commemorate Michael Edward Moriarty and total approximately 1 square foot in total signage. The proposed plaque is in accordance with UDC Section 35-645 and is appropriate.

## RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval based on findings $a$ and $b$ with the stipulation that the applicant verifies the plaque's consistency with existing policies for memorials and landmarks as outlined in UDC Sec. 35-645 and obtains all necessary approvals from applicable City departments.
