4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle D, Title 2, Labor Code, is amended by
6	adding Chapter 83 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 83. PROHIBITION AGAINST LOCAL REGULATION OF CERTAIN
8	EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES
9	Sec. 83.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Employee" means an individual who is employed by
11	an employer for compensation.
12	(2) "Employer" means a person who employs one or more
13	employees.
14	Sec. 83.002. LOCAL REGULATION OF EMPLOYMENT LEAVE
15	PROHIBITED. (a) A political subdivision of this state may not
16	adopt or enforce an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy
17	regulating a private employer's terms of employment relating to any
18	form of employment leave, including paid days off from work for
19	holidays, sick leave, vacation, and personal necessity.
20	(b) An ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy that
21	violates Subsection (a) is void and unenforceable.
22	SECTION 2. Chapter 83, Labor Code, as added by this Act,
23	applies to an ordinance, order, rule, regulation, or policy adopted
24	before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
