Master Interlocal Agreement

- City entered into a Master ILA with County in 2013
- Agreement consolidated several service agreements into one
- 2013 Master ILA expired in September 2018
- Council approved new Master ILA in December 2018

 Master ILA sets out service requirements, deliverables, and compensation. To include:

- Cooperative Purchasing
- Crime Lab
- Hotel Tax Collection
- Jury Pool
- Library Services
- Platting
- Uniform Truancy Case Management

Proposed Additions

- Fire Services and Inspection
- Food Services and Permitting
- Magistration

Master ILA - New Service Area

FIRE SERVICES AND INSPECTIONS

- County will conduct fire/code inspections, certain construction plan reviews and permitting in County owned facilities within city limits
- County will review and permit certain construction plans and conduct fire/code inspections in unincorporated Bexar County
- County must comply with City codes and make information available upon city's request

Master ILA - New Service Area

FOOD SERVICES AND PERMITTING

- County will review and permit food services establishments in unincorporated Bexar County
- City will review, permit, and inspect all food services establishments within city limits

Master ILA - New Service Area

MAGISTRATION

- City will provide magistration of persons taken to the County Justice Intake and Assessment Annex
- County will pay City a total sum of \$294,455 a year for magistration services

Addenda Terms

- Fire Services and Food Services addenda follow the term of the Master ILA
 - October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019
 - Four, one-year, renewal options
- Magistration addendum terminates on January 1, 2020
