AN ORDINANCE

**AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO
AUSTIN CONSTRUCTORS, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$3,474,306.92 FOR THE 2019-2020 TASK ORDER CONTRACT FOR
FLATWORK AND STREET IMPROVEMENTS, PACKAGE 4, OF
WHICH \$188,500.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY SAN ANTONIO
WATER SYSTEM (SAWS) AND \$1,750.00 WILL BE REIMBURSED BY
CPS ENERGY FOR NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS TO ITS EXISTING
INFRASTRUCTURE.**

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WHEREAS, during the FY 2019-2020 Budget process, City Council approved \$9 million for the Sidewalk Maintenance Program, a component of the Infrastructure Management Program and \$2 million for Neighborhood Access and Mobility Program to complete sidewalk and pedestrian-related projects; and

WHEREAS, this task order contract for flatwork and street improvement projects will be utilized for, but are not limited to, the construction of sidewalks, curbs, wheelchair ramps, street improvements and any other work required for the completion of the assigned projects located throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the City received three responsive (3) bids in response to an invitation for bid for the 2019-2020 Task Order Contract for Flatwork & Street Improvements Package 4 released in February 2019; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by Austin Constructors, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$3,474,306.92, of which \$188,500.00 will be reimbursed by San Antonio Water System and \$1,750.00 will be reimbursed by CPS Energy for necessary adjustments to its existing infrastructure; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid submitted by Austin Constructors, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$3,474,306.92 for the 2019-2020 Task Order Contract for Flatwork and Street Improvements, Package 4, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.
