

ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH UNIVERSAL PROTECTION SERVICES, LP DBA ALLIED UNIVERSAL SECURITY SERVICES FOR SECURED AREA ACCESS MANAGEMENT AND MONITORING SERVICES AT THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,800,000.00 FUNDED BY THE AVIATION DEPARTMENT OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio International Airport requires a firm to provide secured area access management and monitoring services in order to meet federal requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Proposal in November, 2018 and received two proposals, and an evaluation committee composed of representatives from the Aviation Department, ITSD and Port San Antonio reviewed the proposals and selected Universal Protection Services, LP d/b/a Allied Universal Security Services as the most qualified respondent; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the execution of a Professional Services Agreement with a five year term in an amount not to exceed \$6,800,000.00 with Allied for this work; **NOW THEREFORE**,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Allied Universal Protection Services, LP d/b/a Allied Security Services in an amount not to exceed \$6,800,000.00 for secured area access management and monitoring services for the San Antonio Airport System, a copy of which is set out in **Exhibit 1**.

Fiscal language will be added upon receipt

SECTION 6. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
