ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTS ESTABLISHING UNIT PRICES FOR GOODS AND SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$671,000.00, AVIALABLE AND INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENTS' FY 2019 ADOPTED BUDGET: (A) GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., FOR ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES, WIRE AND CABLE; (B) CDSI, INC. DBA CHAMPION DIVERSIFIED SERVICES FOR WINDOW WASHING SERVICES FOR THE ALAMODOME; AND (C) TEX DOOR, LTD. FOR PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR AUTOMATIC GATE SYSTEMS.

SECTION 1. The following bids to furnish the City with goods and services on an annual basis as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements: (A) Graybar Electric Company, Inc. for electrical supplies, wire and cable; (B) CDSI, Inc. DBA Champion Diversified Services for window washing services for the Alamodome; and (C) TexDoor, Ltd. for preventive maintenance and repair services for automatic gates systems. The bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to the vendors identified herein.
