### ORDINANCE 2019-05-30-0444

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT #2 TO THE LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH ALAMO CITY YOUTH SOCCER ORGANIZATION FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE OF THE DESIGNATED SPORTS FIELDS AT CULEBRA CREEK PARK FOR A TERM OF 5 YEARS BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2019 AND EXPIRING MAY 31, 2024.

WHEREAS, Alamo City Youth Soccer Organization (ACYSO) has established a community presence since 2009; and

WHEREAS, the league utilizes the designated sports fields at Culebra Creek Park to provide organized youth sports activities year round; the league served over 11,100 area youth in 2018; and

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2008, Bexar County voters approved an extension of the 1999 hotel occupancy and short term motor vehicle rental tax, referred to as the visitor or venue tax; and

WHEREAS, Bexar County identified community projects to fund with this tax extension that would have a positive impact on tourism; and

**WHEREAS**, Alamo City Youth Soccer Organization was selected by Bexar County to receive \$5.23M from the venue tax for the development of a soccer facility in Culebra Creek Park; and

WHEREAS, On May 14, 2009, the City and ACYSO entered into a License Agreement-Bexar County Venue Tax Projects for approximately 43 acres in Culebra Creek Park for the development of a soccer facility; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial term of the license agreement was five years with up to seven five year renewal options subject to the approval of City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the first amendment to the License Agreement was executed on May 15, 2014, to exercise the first renewal option for a five (5) year term; and

WHEREAS, Amendment #2 shall commence on June 1, 2019, and expire May 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of rent, the league shall be responsible for operations and maintenance of the designated sports fields at Culebra Creek Park; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, the league will be permitted to operate concessions with proceeds benefitting their program and to offset the cost of operations and maintenance; and

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**WHEREAS**, the amendment includes administrative renewals for the remaining five renewal terms and a Community Programming Responsibility provision; and

WHEREAS, this provision shall require ACYSO to offer a low cost registration, offer a free adaptive sports league and allow field reservations for leagues and general public; NOW THEREFORE:

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee, is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 2 to the License Agreement with Alamo City Youth Soccer Organization for operations and maintenance of the designated sports fields at Culebra Creek Park extending the term for an additional five (5) year beginning June 1, 2019 and expiring May 31, 2024. A copy of the Amendment No. 2 in substantially final form is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**.

**SECTION 2.** No Fiscal Impact.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.

organization ("Licensee").	

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2009-05-14-0395, passed and approved on May 14, 2009, City and Licensee entered into a License Agreement - Bexar County Venue Tax Projects for a sports complex in Culebra Creek Park; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2014-05-15-0342, passed and approved on May 15, 2014 the City and Licensee approved Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement to exercise the first renewal option for a term of five (5) years beginning on June 1, 2014 and expiring on May 31, 2019; and to clarify reporting requirements; and

WHEREAS, City and Licensee mutually desire to enter into a second amendment to exercise the second renewal option for a term of five (5) years beginning on June 1, 2019 and expiring May 31, 2024, to allow for administrative renewal options and to incorporate Community Programming Responsibilities; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements set forth below, City and Licensee agrees as follows:

### ARTICLE 4. TERM IS MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 4.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

4.2 Subject to the approval of the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department, and so long as Licensee is not then in default of any of the provisions of this Agreement or any agreements between Bexar County and Licensee, this Agreement may be extended for up to seven additional five (5) year renewal options of which two, five (5) year renewal options have been exercised therefore five renewal options remain each renewal option has a five (5) year term. The total maximum term of this Agreement shall not exceed forty (40) years.

#### Paragraph 4.4 is added as follows:

4.4 The second renewal option of this Agreement for a term of five (5) years beginning on June 1, 2019 and expiring on May 31, 2024, if not earlier terminated according to the terms hereof, is hereby exercised

### ARTICLE 29. COMMUNITY PROGRAMMING RESPONSIBILITIES IS ADDED AS FOLLOWS:

29.1 Licensee shall provide discounted or no cost programming offered to the local community which shall include but not limited to:

**29.1.1 Spring & Fall League**: Fall and Spring leagues shall be offered to local youth for a reduced fee.

- **29.1.2 Adaptive Sports:** Offer a minimum of one Adaptive League season per year, at no cost to local youth. Each league shall be a minimum of eight (8) weeks.
- **29.1.3 Field Use:** League shall allow field use reservations, fees collected shall be utilized to maintain the fields and licensed areas.

Except as modified herein, all terms and conditions contained in the Agreement entered into under the authority of the above referenced ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.
