ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH CINTAS CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE, INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE OF PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS LOCATED AT VARIOUS FACILITIES THROUGHOUT THE CITY FOR AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$90,000.00 ANNUALLY. FUNDING FOR THIS CONTRACT IS AVAILABLE FROM THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENTS' FY 2019 ADOPTED BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City released a Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) to provide for the purchase, inspection and maintenance of portable fire extinguishers located at various facilities throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, one response was received and evaluated; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends Cintas Corporation for award of this contract; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Cintas Corporation to provide the City the purchase, inspection and maintenance of portable fire extinguishers located at various facilities throughout the City is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. A copy of the RFCSP is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**. A copy of the proposal may be inspected in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Cintas Corporation. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 budget approved by City Council, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contract through its term as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
