## **ORDINANCE**

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH ALTMAN SPECIALTY PLANTS, LLC FOR BEDDING PLANTS FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$123,000.00, FUNDING IS AVAILABLE AND INCLUDED IN THE RESPECTIVE DEPARTMENTS' FY 2019 ADOPTED BUDGET.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio with a wide variety of bedding plants for various City departments; and

**WHEREAS**, these plants will provide seasonal color to public areas such as the River Walk, Hemisfair Park, Sunken Gardens, Japanese Tea Garden, San Antonio International Airport, and various downtown parks and City facilities; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was submitted by Altman Specialty Plants, LLC; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance authorizes a contract with Altman Specialty Plants, LLC for a period beginning upon award through September 30, 2021, with the option for the City to renew for an additional, one-year period for an estimated annual cost of \$123,000.00; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1.** The bid submitted by Altman Specialty Plants, LLC to provide bedding plants for an estimated annual cost of \$123,000.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. Attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I** is the bid tabulation sheet. Copies of the bid is available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.

**SECTION 2.** Funds will be encumbered upon issuance of purchase orders, and payment is authorized to Altman Specialty Plants, LLC for bedding plants. All expenditures will be in accordance with the Fiscal Year 2019 budget approved by City Council, and such other appropriations necessary to fund the contract through its term as evidenced by subsequent ordinances.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes; otherwise it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
