**ORDINANCE**

**AUTHORIZING THE PARKING FEE STRUCTURE FOR  
THE CITY TOWER GARAGE AND ESTABLISHING NEW  
FEES WITHIN THE PARKING OPERATING AND  
MAINTENANCE FUND.**

**WHEREAS**, beginning July 1, 2019, the City of San Antonio will take ownership of the Frost Bank building and the associated parking garage; and

**WHEREAS**, in preparation for the operation of the newly named City Tower Garage, a fee structure must be approved by the City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1. Fees.** Fees within the Parking Operating and Maintenance Fund are hereby established for the City Tower Garage and portions of Section 19-199 of the City Code are hereby established to read as indicated below. Portions not reproduced below are not changed by this Ordinance.

**Section 19-199. Rates at city parking facilities.**

***(c) Hourly parking:***

	Rate
First ½ hour	\$2.00
1 hour	\$3.00
1 ½ hour	\$5.00
2 hours	\$7.00
2 ½ hours	\$8.00
3 hours	\$9.00
Lost ticket	\$18.00

***(e) Flat rate parking:***

	Rate
City Tower Garage	\$10.00

***(f) Event rate parking:***

	Rate
City Tower Garage	\$15.00

**(g) Monthly parking:**

	Rate
City Tower Garage (regular)	\$120.00
City Tower Garage (reserved)	\$150.00

**SECTION 2. City Code Revisions.** The publisher of the City Code is hereby authorized to revise the City Code to reflect changes provided for in this Ordinance; to correct typographical errors where necessary; and to format and number paragraphs to conform to the existing City Code.

**SECTION 3. Severability.** Should any portion of this Ordinance, for any reason be held illegal, inoperative, invalid, unconstitutional or ineffective, the remainder shall, nevertheless, stand effective and valid as if it had been enacted or ordained without the portion held to be illegal, inoperative, invalid, unconstitutional, or ineffective.

**SECTION 4. Public Meeting.** It is officially found, determined and declared, as a matter of legislative finding, that the meeting at which this Ordinance is adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place and subject matter of public business to be considered at such meeting, including consideration and adoption of this Ordinance, was appropriately given, all as required by law, including the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance is effective July 1, 2019 upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
