1. The undersigned is authorized to approve an exemption.

2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

Through extensive testing and evaluation, the SAPD and San Antonio Police Officers' Labor Relations Committee unanimously chose the Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicle. Their recommendation to purchase Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicles was presented to the Public Safety Council Committee on October 24, 2012. This vehicle is iconic for the City's policing effort and is used by all enforcement divisions (i.e. Park Police, Airport Police, Municipal Court warrant officers, and Animal Care officers). This request compiles with the Collective Bargaining Agreement. This purchase is further supported by current parts and service contracts established for efficient supply of patrol vehicles.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with Ford Dealer which will cost approximately \$ 5.076,597.00
