San Antonio Public Library Construction Update July 2019

FY 2019 Capital Projects

San Pedro Branch Library Renovations - \$416,500 (FY19 Capital Funds) Scope of Work

- Restoration to buildings windows, doors, masonry and plaster walls
- Restroom renovations and building system upgrades (where needed)
- Building envelope improvements to include roofing and exterior safety and security lighting upgrades
- This project will require a brief closure once approved by Library Facilities Committee and Board of Trustees
- Estimated completion: Fall/Winter 2019

Current Status: Additional MEP design services complete. HVAC improvements design underway. Transportation and Capital Improvements (TCI) to present final design plan and schedule to Library Facilities Committee in August (for parking lot changes). Library staff is coordinating work with Parks and TCI on larger San Pedro Springs Park Bond project which will involve replacing the parking lot and require branch closure once approved by Library Facilities Committee and Board of Trustees. Project timeline will coincide with larger TCI/Parks San Pedro Springs Park project (SPSP). SPSP Project will include new parking area for Library. Currently scheduled to begin construction Jan/Feb 2020

Brook Hollow Branch Library Foundation Repairs - \$100,000 (FY19 Deferred Maintenance Funds)

Scope of Work: Mitigate water intrusion affecting building foundation as indicated in previously prepared structural assessment report

- Current Status: Exterior drainage repairs complete; Piezometer is measuring static pressures under building, and is being monitored monthly. After five test-visits, no moisture has been detected under the building. Testing will continue through August.
- No closure was required. Work was coordinated to minimize any impact on patron use of the facility.
- Carpet replacement in affected area scheduled for August/September.
- On schedule to be completed by September 30th.

Branch Parking Lot Improvement Projects (3) - \$250,000 (FY19 Deferred Maintenance Funds)Igo Branch Library - \$98,000Cody Branch Library - \$75,000Semmes Branch Library - \$77,000

Scope of Work: Repairs/replacement of damaged/faulty asphalt and damaged concrete curbs or sidewalks

- Construction work is being coordinated in manner to minimize public impact at all project locations.
- Estimated completion: September 30, 2019, weather permitting.

Current Status: Parking lot improvements at Semmes were completed during the interior renovation closure. Cracks sealed, fire-lane markings and stripping complete, and drainage improvements installed.

POs have been issued to contractor; **Cody Branch Library** work began on July 8 to be complete by end of July. **Igo Branch Library** is planned to start July/August 2019. All work is on schedule to be completed by September 30th.

Current Status: <u>HVAC Upgrades</u>: Contract negotiations are on-going. Library Facilities Committee and Board of Trustees will be updated regarding temporary closure schedule. <u>Foundation Repairs</u>: Structural assessment on cracked patio foundation found no significant structural concerns; only aesthetic issue with cracked terrazzo tile. Work will be coordinated concurrent with the HVAC project, brief closure will be required and brought before Facilities and Library Board for approval. Estimated completion to be determined.

Potranco Branch Library

Description: Courtyard and interior enhancements, shade improvements

Funds: \$50,000 (Semmes Foundation Donation)

Location/District: Potranco Branch Library, 8765 TX 151 Access Road, District 6

Project Scope: Install benches with power accessibility, tables and chairs, strategic placement of power towers throughout courtyard, improvements to interior lighting and acoustics in quiet room, shade options over courtyard. **Estimated Completion**: FY 2019

Current Status: As previously approved by Library Board, a Shade Canopy will be installed as part of the Courtyard improvement project begun last year. Canopy design has been completed and approved by Library staff. Canopy design is under review with YMCA (per Lease Agreement). Canopy fabrication and installation to be complete by Summer 2019.

Schaefer Branch Library Master Plan for Site Amenities

- Master Plan will include additional parking, driveway connecting the parking lot to the neighborhood and a walking trail with site amenities.
- SAPL met with Landscape Architect Larry Clark on May 16 to begin design of a walking trail and Master Site Plan to guide further development at Schaefer Branch Library.
- Master Plan will include additional parking, driveway connecting the parking lot to the neighborhood, and a walking trail w/ site amenities
- Once design is complete for the Master Plan, staff will present to Facilities Committee and Library Board as appropriate.
- Design completion estimated in Fall 2019
