ORDINANCE

APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH CRAFCO, INC. TO PROVIDE FIVE REPLACEMENT TRAILER MOUNTED CRACK SEALER MACHINES FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$406,179.40. FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$162,471.76 IS AVAILABE IN THE FY 2019 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND, WITH ADDITIONAL FUNDING SUBJECT TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS.

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WHEREAS, an offer was submitted by Crafco, Inc., through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (a.k.a. the "Buyboard"), to provide the City with five replacement trailer mounted crack sealer machines used for street maintenance for a total cost of \$406,179.40; and

WHEREAS, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Ordinance No. 97097 on January 30, 2003; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The offer from Crafco, Inc. to provide the City five replacement trailer mounted crack sealer machines for a total cost of \$406,179.40 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount up to \$162,471.76 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001, and GL 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2019 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Additional funding of \$243,707.64 is contingent upon City Council approval of subsequent budgets during the term of this contract.

SECTION 4. Payment not to exceed the budgeted amount is authorized to Crafco, Inc. for the purchase of five replacement trailer mounted crack sealer machines used for street maintenance, and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project

Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage by eight or more affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective on the tenth day after passage.
