

ORDINANCE 2019-08-08-0592

**AWARDING A TASK ORDER CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO E-Z BEL CONSTRUCTION, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,792,775.00 FOR NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AND OTHER TRAFFIC PROJECTS OF SIMILAR SCOPE AT LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE CITY.**

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**WHEREAS**, the proposed FY 2020 Budget includes \$1 million to continue the citywide Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance authorizes a two-year task order construction contract for neighborhood traffic calming construction projects identified through a traffic engineering evaluation as part of the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program and other traffic projects of similar scope; and

**WHEREAS**, City advertised for bids for a task order contract for traffic calming construction in April 2019 and received two (2) bids which were opened in May 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid submitted by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$1,792,775.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The lowest responsive bid by E-Z Bel Construction, LLC in the not to exceed amount of \$1,792,775.00 for a task order construction contract for neighborhood traffic calming construction projects and other traffic projects of similar scope, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this ordinance will be identified when work orders are issued. If funding for any work orders is not previously appropriated, funding will be identified and appropriated through subsequent City Council action. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with Operating and/or Capital Budgets for current and future fiscal years.

**SECTION 3:** Payment not to exceed \$1,792,775.00 within the term of the agreement, it is authorized to be encumbered with a purchase order and made payable to E-Z Bel Construction, LLC., neighborhood traffic calming construction projects and other traffic projects of similar scope at locations throughout the City.

**SECTION 4:** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject

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to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
