The bid submitted by D&L Communication Systems, Inc. to provide and install a video display system at the Alamodome for a total cost of \$1,299,240.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. Copies of the bids are available for inspection in the offices of the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department.
