

ORDINANCE 2019-08-15-0630

ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID, INCLUDING ONE ADDITIVE ALTERNATE, AND AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO NEW AGE GENERAL CONTRACTORS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$557,397.00 FOR REHABILITATION OF BRIDGES LOCATED ON LOYOSA STREET, W. MARKET STREET, EVANS ROAD AND ROLAND ROAD, LOCATED IN DISTRICTS 1, 2 AND 10.

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WHEREAS, the Citywide Bridge Program is a \$23.4 million 2012-2017 Bond program funded Project intended to replace or build new City owned bridge structures rated as deficient, either due to deterioration, compromised structural integrity, insufficient drainage capacity or inadequate traffic provisions or a combination thereof; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance awards a construction contract, as part of the Citywide Bridge Program, for four bridge locations to replace bridge railings which will include the rehabilitation and replacement of concrete substructure of each of these bridges' railing system and associated bridge panels; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised the project in March 2019 and received and opened three (3) bids in April 2019; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance accepts the lowest responsive bid with one additive alternate submitted by New Age General Contractors, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$557,397.00 for rehabilitation of bridges located on Loyosa Street, W. Market Street, Evans Road and Roland Road; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid with one additive alternate by New Age General Contractors, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$557,397.00 for the rehabilitation of bridges located on Loyosa Street, W. Market Street, Evans Road and Roland Road, is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon execution of a contract by the successful bidder and the deposit of all required bonds and insurance certificates.

SECTION 2. Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to New Age General Contractors, Inc. for rehabilitation of bridges located on Loyosa Street, W. Market Street, Evans Road and Roland Road in Districts 1, 2 and 10 as part of the Citywide Bridge Program in the amount not to exceed \$557,397.00 per the table below:



SECTION 3. Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.


SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.


