2. An exemption according to Section 252.022 of the Local Government Code exists. More specifically, the following event has occurred:

The San Antonio Police Department's Texas Anti Gang Unit (TAG) would like to purchase concealable body armor to include ballistic vests and accessories, helmets, and shields. The purchase would fall under the same requirements and remain consistent with the recent concealable body armor purchase made for SWAT, Bomb, K-9, ROP, Narcotics, and Special Crime Units utilizing Buyboard Contract 524-17.

3. Because the exemption stated above exists, the City of San Antonio intends to contract with GT Distributors which will cost approximately \$ 79,536.00.
