AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000.00 FOR LABORATORY INFRASTRUCTURE SUPPORT OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S BIOWATCH PROGRAM BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 18, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 17, 2020.

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WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's (Metro Health) laboratory services branch provides analytical support for various public health programs; and

WHEREAS, the laboratory as a whole is comprised of several testing areas that are designed to serve a variety of functions, customers and regulatory agencies in a 29-county region which include San Antonio and Bexar County; and

WHEREAS, the laboratory structure is divided by regulatory programs and functions: consumer microbiology and testing, infectious disease surveillance, bioterrorism/influenza surveillance, rabies analysis and food surveillance; and

WHEREAS, these funds will provide laboratory infrastructure support for the BioWatch laboratory program activities; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is hereby authorized to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 for laboratory infrastructure support of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's BioWatch Program beginning September 18, 2019 through September 17, 2020.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health district or designee is authorized to execute any and all necessary documents to effectuate said acceptance of funds.

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SECTION 3. Upon award, a new fund and internal order will be created for use in the accounting for the fiscal transaction in the acceptance of this grant and the amounts listed above totaling an amount up to \$35,000.00 will be appropriated in said funds. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I** is approved. A formal final budget which will include Internal Order numbers and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
