## Program Priorities

### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE ABUSE & PREVENTION SERVICES**

Support policies and programs to prevent domestic violence. Furthermore, support funding for prevention education and intervention services to effectively address this issue in our community.

## Legislative Issues

### **FIREARMS SAFETY**

Support comprehensive legislation to prevent gun violence, including policies that require background checks for gun sales.

  - Select Committees on Mass Violence Prevention and Community Safety



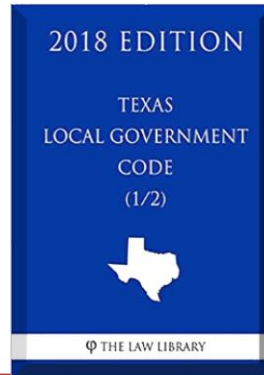
# Council Resolution

- Resolution calling for action to address gun violence passed on August 15
- Document sent to U.S. Senators, Texas leadership and Bexar County delegation



# Local Limitations

- **Texas Local Government Code - Chapter 229**
  - Prohibits local regulation of firearms
  - 86<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session expanded limits places on local governments
