- \$30 million available to reimburse communities for expenditures from 01/2019 to 06/2019
- Application submitted to the EFSP Board on September 6
- Announcement expected late September or early October

Federal Appropriations - Budget Deal

- Bipartisan Budget Act of 2019 signed on August 1
- Congress and White House reached a deal on federal budget levels for the next two Fiscal Years
- Adds over \$100 billion in new spending over FY 2019


Federal Appropriations - FY 2020

 House leadership working on temporary funding bill


