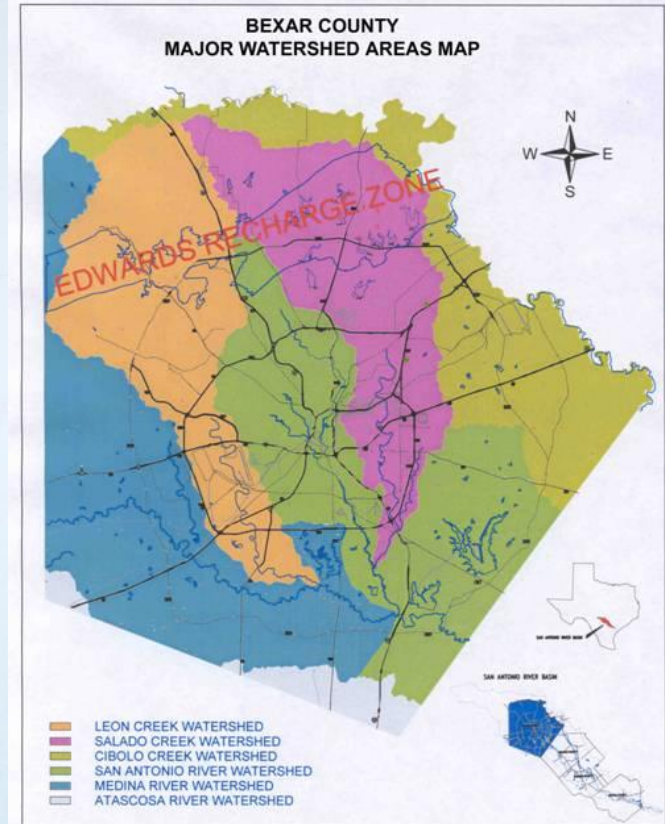

BACKGROUND

- Bexar County Flood Control (CIP) established in 2007 by Commissioners Court to manage design and construction of regional flood control projects
- Original ILA approved by City Council in 2009 to establish terms and conditions for 18 regional flood control projects within City limits to be managed and constructed by Bexar County
- Three subsequent amendments added 34 regional control projects and 53 High Water Detection Sites (HWDS) to be constructed by the County and maintained by the City





- Fourth amendment will add seven additional HWDS to be designed and constructed by the County and maintained by the City:

- Sidney Brooks Dr. west of S. New Braunfels Ave.
- Old O'Connor Rd. at the intersection of Lookout Rd.
- Lookout Rd. at the intersection of Old O'Connor Rd.
- N. North Loop Rd. north of N. Park Rd.
- Vance Jackson northwest of Wurzbach Rd.
- Holbrook Rd. at Salado Creek
- West Ave. south of Interpark Blvd.





- Most efficient way for City to provide funding, project management, construction, maintenance and repair upon completion and acceptance of projects
- Supports City policy to collaborate with other governmental agencies for maintaining and improving infrastructure
- Enhances public safety





RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of an ordinance amending the Interlocal Agreement with Bexar County for regional watershed flood control projects as part of Bexar County Flood Control Capital Improvement Projects (CIP).
