

Solicitation Overview

Project Overview

- The Planning Department requested qualifications for the development of 18 Sub-Area Plans that will serve to implement the SA Tomorrow Comprehensive Plan, and create a Future Land Use Map for the entire city.
- Selected consultant must have demonstrated experience in directing the process for creating Sub-Area Plans, including GIS/geospatial analysis of existing conditions, market analysis, graphic design skills, drone photography and 3D modeling, experience in facilitating public engagement activities, drafting of such plans, development of web-based e-plan documents and project websites, and working as an extension of City staff in engaging the public to develop consensus around a shared vision for the future of the City.



Recommended Award

The evaluation committee met on September 26, 2019, and by consensus, recommends awarding a contract to the respondent.

This item is tentatively scheduled for Council consideration on December 5, 2019.




