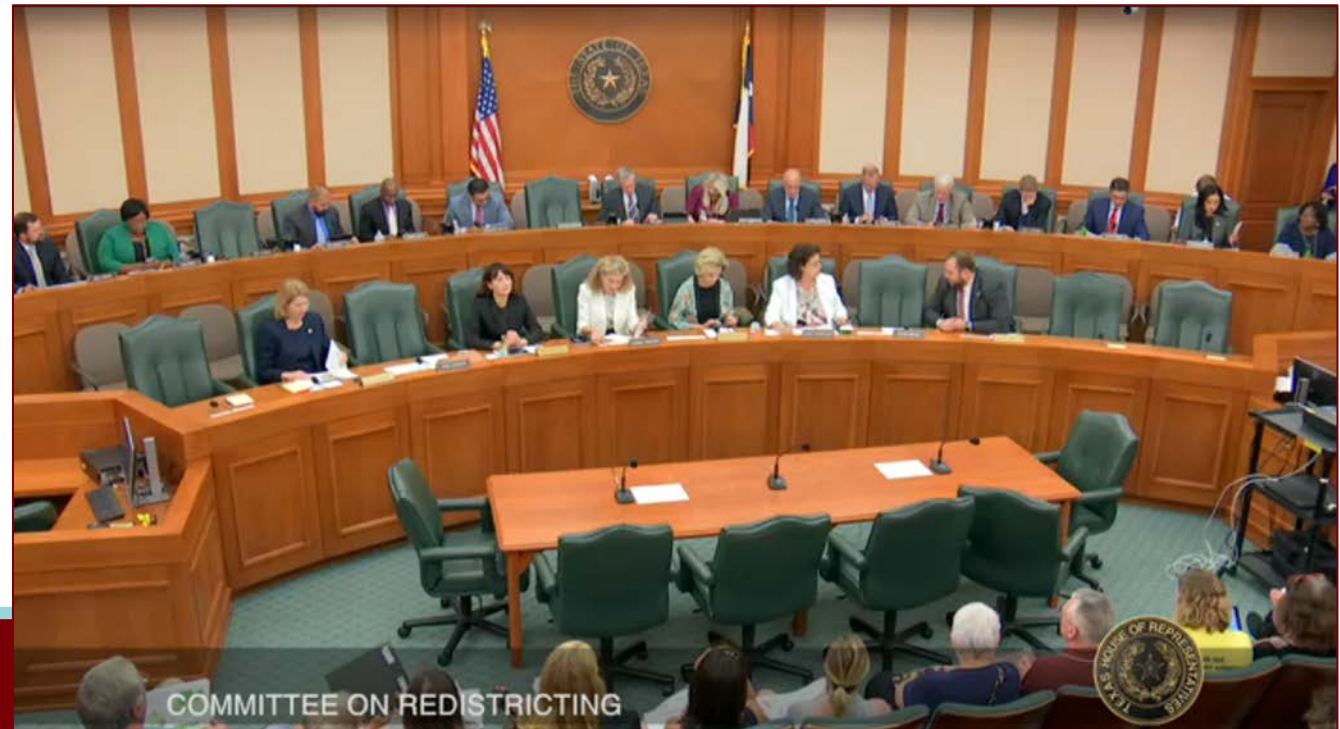

# Redistricting



- Decennial Census count used to:
  - Reapportion the U.S House of Representatives
  - Determine number of electoral college votes per state
  - Redraw congressional and state legislative boundaries



# House Redistricting Committee



- Assists Legislature in making redistricting decisions
- Holds hearings to gather community input
- Hearings begun September 10
  - Austin - Sept. 10
  - San Antonio - Sept. 12
  - Fort Worth - Oct. 9
  - Dallas - Oct. 10
  - Houston - Oct. 22-23
  - Corpus Christi - Nov. 4



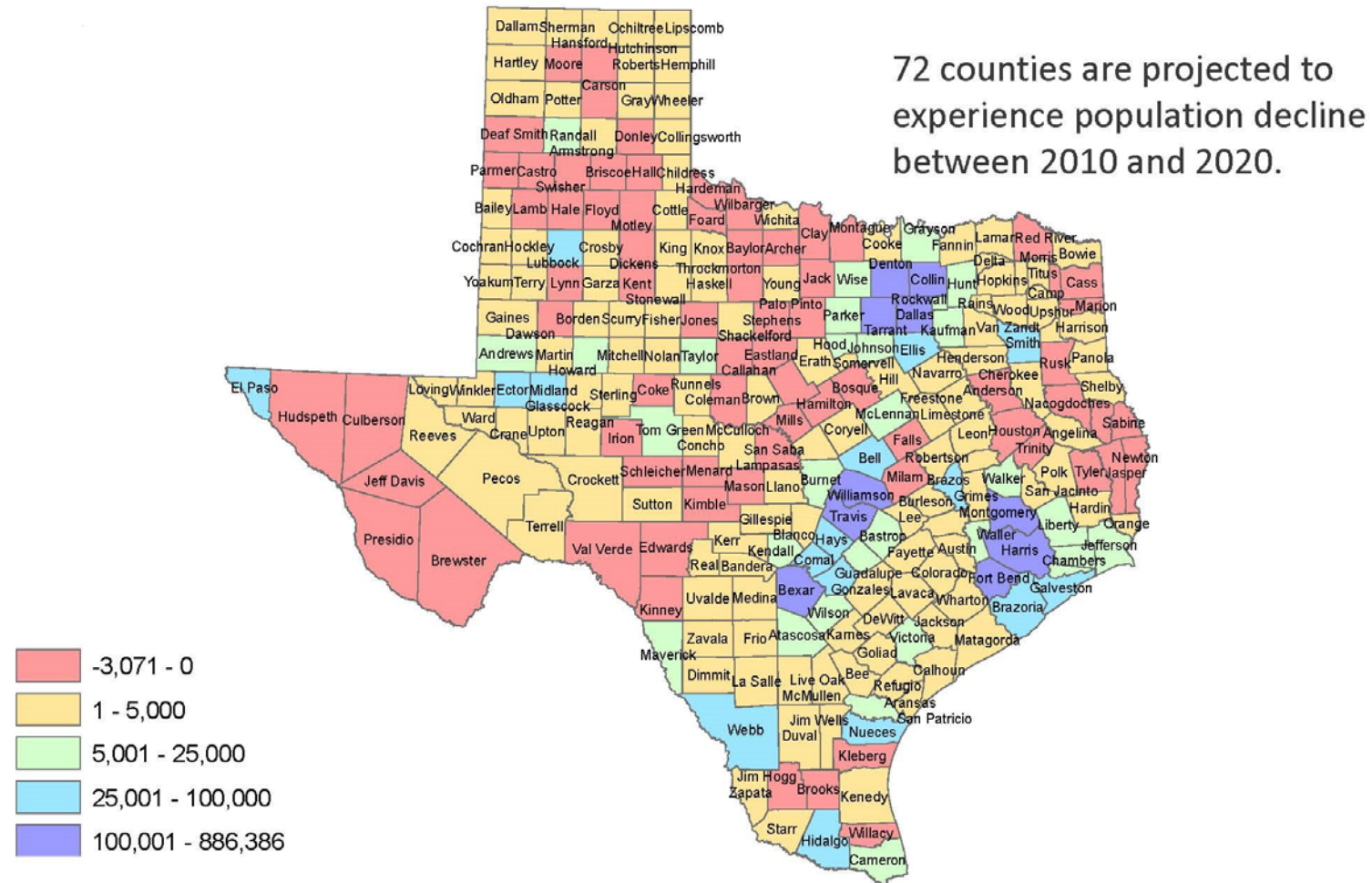

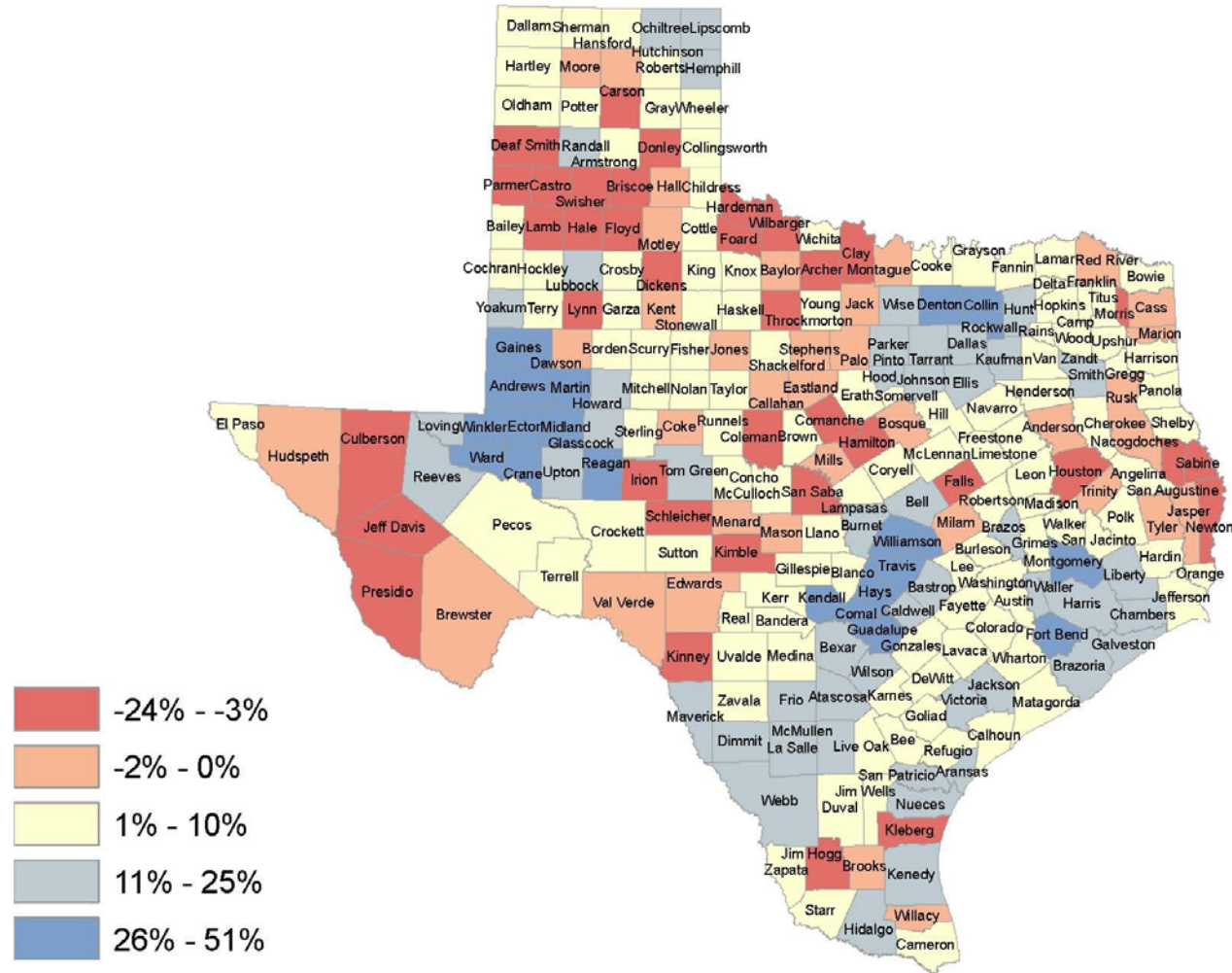


# State Population Shift



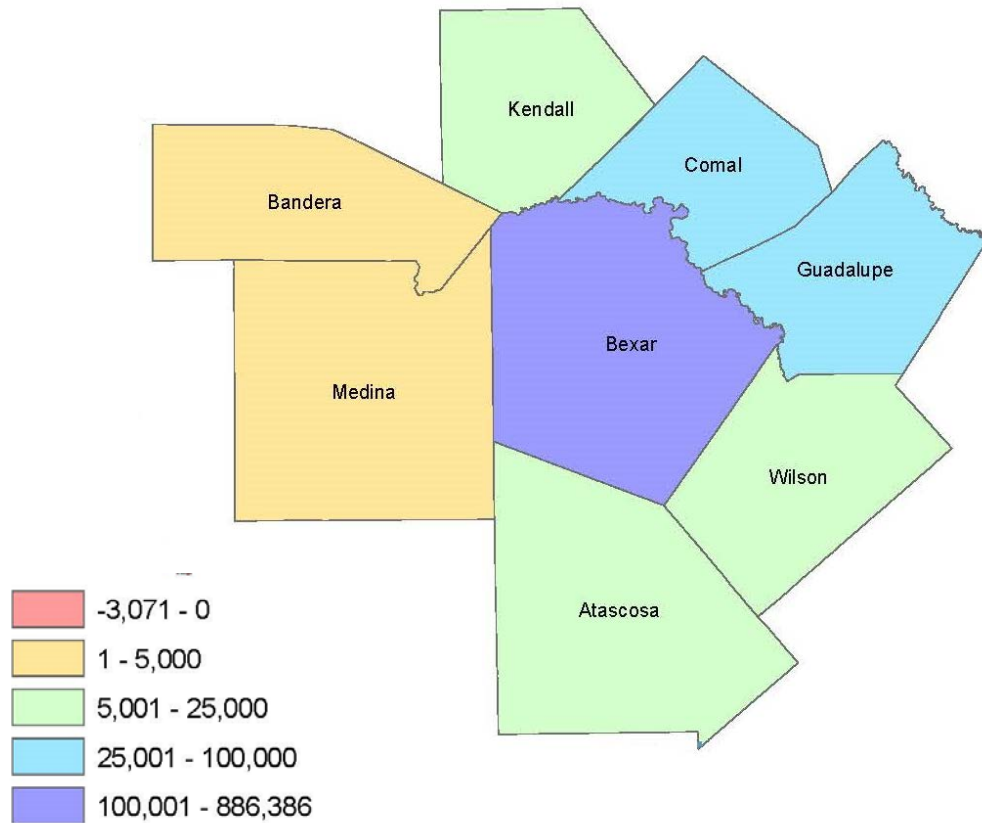

# Statewide Growth 2010-2020

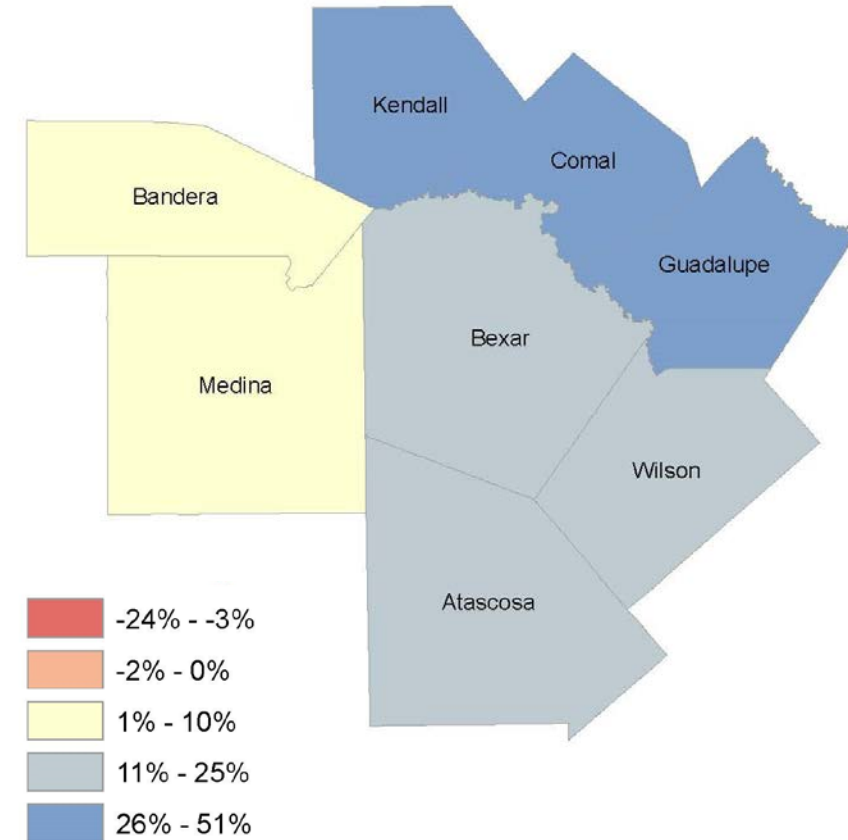
