AN ORDINANCE

**APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT
FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$320,000.00 FROM
THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE
OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, JUVENILE JUSTICE
AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION FOR THE
2019 SUPPORTING VICTIMS OF GANG
VIOLENCE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Program awarded a grant to the San Antonio Police Department for the 2019 Supporting Victims of Gang Violence Grant Program for the period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022, in the amount of \$320,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant application, which was authorized under a Special Category Grant Opportunity Submission Authorization Request, was submitted to the BJS on June 10, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the grant, which will fund two Violence Prevention Advocates, will be used to reduce youth offending and victimization, improve responses to children's exposure to violence, and expand and enhance the capabilities of the Community Engagement Program to respond to and support youth victims of gang violence; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require an in-kind or cash match; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police and designee are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in an amount up to \$320,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, for the 2019 Supporting Victims of Gang Violence Grant Program for the grant period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2022.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of the award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created for the grant funds in an amount up to \$320,000.00, to be appropriated in said fund. A formal final budget which will include a department specific fund, an Internal Order number, and General Ledger numbers will be submitted by the department upon award. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit A**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 3. The proposed personnel complement of two (2) positions, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit B**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City books.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
