





I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda for the next meeting of the Governance Committee:

Direct City Manager and Executive team to:

- Immediately develop and implement a formal, year-round, sustained training program that focuses on innovative best practices for fully implementing the city's Complete Streets and Vision Zero policies for all transportation and SA Tomorrow planning, projects and programs.
- Ensure that all city employees, consultants and contractors involved in implementing. Complete Streets and Vision Zero mandates, including the budgeting, planning, engineering, designing, constructing, maintaining, managing and enforcing these policies are included in this training.

Conduct a systematic review and revision of all policies, procedures, implementation manuals and departmental organization structures to ensure that Complete Street and Vision Zero principles are fully integrated into ongoing planning, budgeting and implementing operations and the development of UDC amendments.
