Project & Solicitation Overview

Background:

- 1. Organic materials collected from the green cart collection program is processed by a vendor.
- 2. Giving back to nature in the form of compost.
- 3. Current vendor indicated price would go up.
- 4. This past summer, we issued an RFP for organic materials processing.
- 5. Only one response was received and was higher than expected.
- 6. The RFP was cancelled.



Renew New Earth Contract 1 Year

Tomorrow's Agenda:

- 1. Renew New Earth contract for 1 year.
- 2. Negotiated a favorable rate of \$24 per ton. (cheaper than landfilling)
- Developed partnership with Parks & Rec and TCI to test CoSA compost demand. (252 City parks and TCI projects)
- 4. Buy back compost at 1/3 of market rate.
- 5. Aligns with the R&RR Plan by diverting materials from landfill and eventually getting to a 60% recycling rate.



Puts CoSA in a better position to negotiate when one (1) year agreement with New Earth ends.


Two Part Strategic Plan

- 1. Renew/Amend New Earth Contract 1 year
 - Provides time to engage vendors.
- 2. New RFP
 - Incorporate feedback from RFI.
 - Cast a wider net and provide more time to attract more potential respondents.
 - Consider having multiple contracts to leverage efficiency.
 - Utilize our Nelson Gardens site where we currently process mulch.

 Processing of the material requires a manual sorting process to remove noncompostable material


