

12 appropriations bills





- Defense
- Homeland Security
- Commerce-Justice-Science
- Financial Services
- Labor, Health and Human Services-Education
- Agriculture

- Energy and Water Development

- Legislative Branch
- Military Construction-Veterans Affairs
- State-Foreign Operations
- Transportation, Housing and Urban Development



- Congress passed final FY20 spending bill in December
- Funds federal government through September 30, 2020
- \$738B Defense
- \$632B Non-Defense
- \$49B in additional funding across all federal spending



Housing and Urban Development (HUD)

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): \$3.4B, an increase of \$100 million
- HOME Investment Partnerships: \$1.35B, an increase of \$100 million
- Healthy Homes & Lead Hazards: \$290M, an increase of \$10 million
- Homeless Assistance Grants: \$2.8B, an increase of \$141 million
- Choice Neighborhoods Initiative: \$175M, an increase of \$25 million



U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT)

- BUILD Grant program: \$1B, an increase of \$100 million
- Airport Improvement Program (AIP): \$3.35B, level funding





- U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ)
 - Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grants (JAG): \$547M, an increase of \$123M million
 - Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS): \$235M, an increase of \$10 million
 - Violence Against Women Act (VAWA): \$502M, an increase of \$5 million



- U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS)
 - Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI): \$665M, an increase of \$25 million
 - Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG): \$355M, an increase of \$5 million
- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)
 - Brownfields Project Grant Program: \$89M, an increase of \$2 million







- U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC)
 - 2020 Census: \$6.69B, toward activities to ensure the efficient and adequate deployment
- U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)



- Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP): \$3.7B, an increase of \$50 million
- Community Services Block Grant (CSBG): \$740M, an increase of \$15 million



Military Construction - JBSA

- \$74M BMT recruit dormitory
- \$69M Aquatics tank
- \$9.3M Ground based training system simulator
- \$19M Training system centralized training facility
