Resolution recommending the closure to vehicular travel an improved portion of Aransas Avenue Public Right-of-Way and repurpose the area to include pedestrian facilities, a median and green space in Council District 2, a 2017-2022 General Obligation Bond Pedestrian Mobility and Street Project.
