ORDINANCE

APPROVING A TASK ORDER TO A JOB ORDER CONTRACT WITH SABINAL GROUP, LLC IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$241,090.00 FOR THE RAINTREE PARK PROJECT, A 2017 BOND FUNDED PROJECT. FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE FROM 2017 - 2022 GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROGRAM AND ARE INCLUDED IN THE FY 2020 – FY 2025 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2017, the City approved the 2017 Bond Program authorizing \$370,000.00 for improvements to Raintree Park located in Council District 10; and

WHEREAS, the project will provide for swings, a shade canopy over the swings, a picnic table and a concrete walkway; and

WHEREAS, construction is anticipated to begin in May 2020 and estimated to be completed by September 2020; and

WHEREAS, this project was selected to utilize Job Order Contracting (JOC), an alternative project delivery method in which ten contractors were approved through Ordinance 2019-02-21-0134 by City Council on February 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the use of the JOC delivery method provides the City with on-call construction, renovation and maintenance services for City buildings and facilities; and

WHEREAS, assignment of JOC contractors to specific jobs is based on the contractor's current workload, overall capacity, and familiarity with a specific facility, expertise in completing specific task and/or managing a specific trade needed to carry out the requested repair or

Ehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, of the ten contractors, Sabinal Group, LLC was selected to submit an estimate and project schedule for this project; and

WHEREAS, this task order will be awarded in compliance with the Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Program requirements awarded with the JOC, which Goal Setting Committee set a 24% Minority/Women Business Enterprise (M/WBE) subcontracting goal and a 4% African American Business Enterprise subcontracting goal.; and

WHEREAS, Sabinal Group has committed to a 24% M/WBE and 4% AABE subcontractor participation; and

WHEREAS, the Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form, as required by the City's Ethics Ordinance for all Projects where subjective criteria are used to select the contractor or consultant rather than by low bid, is attached; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department or designee, is authorized to execute a task order to a Job Order Contract with Sabinal Group, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$241,090.00 for the Raintree Park project, a 2017 Bond funded project, located in Council District 10.

SECTION 2. Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to Sabinal Group LLC in an amount not to exceed \$241,090.00. Payment is in support of the Raintree Park 2017 Project, using Fund 45099000, with WBS 23-01700-05-02-01 and General Ledger 5201140. Funding is provided by the 2017 General Obligation Bond Program and is budgeted in the FY2020-FY2025 CIP Budget.

Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
