COVID 19 City Emergency Response Reimbursement


- Will seek federal reimbursement

 Health Services grant




COVID 19 - ECONOMIC IMPACT


- Measures taken to slow down spread of virus have created Global Economic Disruption





COSA HOT Tax Allocation




COVID 19 – San Antonio Impact Hotel Occupancy Tax
