

# Addendum to the Fifth Declaration

Friday, April 3: City and County Issue Additional Measures

- **Long Term Care Facilities**

- In-Person service provider for nursing home or assisted living facility may only work in one facility
  - *Examples include nurses, phlebotomist, lab technicians*
- Must follow all CDC guidance to take proactive steps to protect the health of residents and preserve the health care workforce

# Addendum to the Fifth Declaration

- City will revoke Certificate of Occupancy for violating businesses
- All Food, Household Staples Retail, including those doing pick-up/delivery
  - Limit the amount of people at pickup or in an establishment – social distancing
  - Implement an organized line system – 6 feet apart
  - Post in a highly visible location, the establishment's guidelines on limitations of people and line system

# Addendum to the Fifth Declaration

- Parks

- Closing of all recreational areas where social distancing and sanitizing requirements are difficult or impossible to meet
  - *Playgrounds, outdoor exercise equipment, tennis courts, skate plazas, splash pads, basketball courts*
- City / County Parks closed Saturday and Sunday of Easter/Passover Weekend
  - Park trails, linear parks and greenways will remain open for walking, running or biking while maintaining social distancing

- Closing of all Golf Courses and Driving Ranges

# Addendum to the Fifth Declaration

- Council Action - Extend Fifth Declaration until April 30
  - Consistent with the Governor's Order and County Judge's Order extending until April 30
  - Pursuant to the Texas Disaster Act the Mayor may issue Emergency Declarations but the Council has the purview to extend Declarations.
