AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION NATIONAL EXPLOSIVES DETECTION CANINE TEAM PROGRAM AT THE SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020 AND REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF UP TO \$126,250.00 FOR THE FY 2020 AIRPORT OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE FUND.

HEREAS, in November 2014, through Ordinance 2014-11-13-09

WHEREAS, in November 2014, through Ordinance 2014-11-13-0913, the City entered into a five-year reimbursement grant agreement with the Transportation Security Administration for the City to provide canine and personnel explosives detection training at the San Antonio International Airport and for the TSA to provide reimbursement of certain operating expenses per canine team plus a stipend; and

WHEREAS, the City and TSA wish to retroactively extend the program from January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020, and authorize further extensions upon mutual agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the City will be reimbursed up to \$126,250.00 to the FY 202 Airport Operating and Maintenance Fund of the Aviation Department for continued participation in this program; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Aviation Department or designee, hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents to extend the participation in the National Explosives Detection Canine Team Program at the San Antonio International Airport Reimbursable Agreement Program with the Transportation Security Administration for the reimbursement of up to \$126,250.00 for law enforcement support at the San Antonio International Airport for a period from January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020, and to further extend the Agreement upon mutual consent of the parties.

SECTION 2. Upon agreement, a final budget will be submitted by the San Antonio Department of Aviation, a new fund and internal order number will be created, into which the reimbursed amount will be appropriated.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
