ORDINANCE 2020-04-16-0266

APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$235,000.00 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$480,625.00, FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF STATE HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE TEXAS HEALTHY MOTHERS AND BABIES PROGRAM GRANT.

* * * * *

WHEREAS, women should schedule a prenatal care visit as soon as they know or suspect that they are pregnant, ideally within the first trimester of pregnancy; however, close to 40% of Texas women, primarily African American and Hispanic women, receive either late or no prenatal care; and

WHEREAS, no or inadequate prenatal care is more likely to lead to low birth weight babies and pregnancy-related complications; and

WHEREAS, currently in Bexar County, more than 1 in 5 pregnant adolescents receive no prenatal care; and

WHEREAS, as of 2015, 67% of all live births were from mothers who entered prenatal care in the first trimester, which indicates that one in three mothers do not access prenatal care in these crucial first three months of their pregnancy; and

WHEREAS, barriers reported by mothers to obtaining prenatal care include lacking information about prenatal care and health insurance, having difficulty making appointments, not having enough time, transportation, and childcare, and not knowing they are pregnant; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) identified the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (Metro Health) as a participant for the Healthy Texas Babies program, subsequently renamed the Healthy Texas Mothers and Babies program, through a non-competitive selection process; and

WHEREAS, Council approved an application to and acceptance of funds up to \$320,625.00 for a 5-year project period, Ordinance No. 2017-12-14-1007; and

WHEREAS, DSHS has subsequently awarded the Department more than originally anticipated for the first 3 years of the project period; and

WHEREAS, to date, Metro Health has received \$245,625.00 and anticipates receiving an additional \$117,500.00 for each of the two remaining years of the project period; and

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WHEREAS, this would bring the total receipts to \$480,625.00, thus requiring Council to approve the acceptance of additional funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds, made available to Metro Health, will be used to develop collaborations to support collective impact in improving birth outcomes, maternal, perinatal and infant health and to reduce disparities in infant mortality; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, hereby authorized to accept additional grant funds in the amount not to exceed \$235,000.00 from the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) for the Healthy Texas Mothers and Babies Program for the period starting September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2022.

SECTION 2. The City Manager or designee, or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee, is further authorized to initiate, negotiate, and execute any and all necessary documents and grant contract to effectuate the acceptance of the grant referenced in Section 1 of this ordinance and to execute contract amendments pertaining to this contract to include a) carry-over funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; b) line item budget revisions authorized by the funding agency; c) modifications to the performance measures authorized by the funding agency and listed in the contract so long as the terms of the amendment stay within the general parameters of the intent of the grant; d) no cost extensions; e) amendments which will provide supplemental grant funds to the grant by the funding agency in an amount up to 20% of the total amount awarded to the grant inclusive of this ordinance; f) reimbursement increases of administrative funds for each participant served; g) amendments funding one time equipment purchases or defined program services; and h) changes in regulations mandated by the funding agency.

SECTION 3. Upon approval, a sum not to exceed \$235,000.00 will be appropriated in Internal Order 136000000xxx and fund 2201636xxx from DSHS. The proposed budget, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved and adopted for entry in the City's books. A formal budget will be provided upon acceptance of funds.

SECTION 4. A personnel complement of one (1) position, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I**, is approved.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

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SECTION 6. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
