ORDINANCE

APPROVING CONTRACTS WITH EQUIPMENT DEPOT AND HOLTCAT TO PROVIDE THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WITH TWO OFF-ROAD EQUIPMENT UNITS FOR A TOTAL COST OF \$247,471.00. FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FROM THE FY 2020 EQUIPMENT RENEWAL AND REPLACEMENT FUND BUDGET.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San with replacement, off-road equipment units; and

WHEREAS, the equipment includes one, wheeled asphalt paver for street paving projects and one, articulated wheeled loader to remove drainage channel debris; and

WHEREAS, Equipment Depot submitted the low bid for item 2 for a total cost of \$75,926.00; and

WHEREAS, HoltCat submitted the low bid for item 6 in the amount of \$171,545.00; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures will be in accordance with the applicable fiscal year's budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids submitted by Equipment Depot (Item 2) and HoltCat (Item 6) for a total cost of \$247,471.00 are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits, insurance certificates and endorsements. The bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Exhibit I**.

SECTION 2. Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$247,471.00 is available in Fund 72001000, Cost Center 3503200001 and General Ledger 5709080 as part of the Fiscal Year 2020 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 3. Payment in the amount of \$75,926.00 is authorized to Equipment Depot and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 4. Payment in the amount of \$171,545.00 is authorized to HoltCat and should be encumbered with a purchase order.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers,
