NUTRITION SERVICES

- All meals and snacks provided free of charge
- Special diet meals available
- Foods from home not permitted
- Meals served family style, focus on highquality ingredients
- Children encouraged to try new foods
- Focus on reducing waste and sustainability
 - Reusable silverware, milk pitchers
 - Compost food waste for gardens





FOOD TO FAMILIES



Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, staff has continued to provide much-needed, nutritional meals to our families

- Nearly 6,000 boxes of food distributed over 8 weeks
- Home delivery for families with no transportation
- CACFP-compliant lunches for children and siblings added in Week 6



CULINARY HEALTH EDUCATION FOR FAMILIES (CHEF)

- Garden to Table curriculum created by CHEF, adopted by Pre-K 4 SA
- CHEF implemented at all four Education Centers in Oct 2019 in collaboration with SAFB
- All 100 classrooms cook at least one recipe a month
- Ingredients not on hand are provided by SAFB

COVID-19

- New recipe and video sent out weekly in English and Spanish
- Letter noting skills needed, general safety and health reminders, and the CHEF tenant that aligns with the recipe
