

### CONSIDERATION FOR THE BOARD

#### Board Review/Input

Board briefing of the recommendation for Pre-K 4 SA to award Competitive Education Grant contracts to 9 grant awardees for one year (2020-2021 grant cycle) with an overall **value not to exceed \$2,700,000**, which includes \$2,384,495 in Competitive Grants awards and \$250,000 for goods and services for child development centers in the Shared Services Alliance; In kind professional learning for all awardees with a value of \$675,000 and \$212,500 for Reading Academies for school districts.
