Brief Description of Item(s) and Use:

This change order will provide the Fire Department with an extension to the initial term of the contract through June 30, 2021.

This contract will provide the San Antonio Fire and Aviation Departments with a contractor to install, remove and repair electronic safety equipment and communications equipment for the Fire Department and other City vehicles. Fire and Aviation Departments utilize this contract to ensure safe and reliable operation of the 170 fire vehicles and heavy-duty apparatuses currently in service. Contractor will provide repair services and installation of lights, sirens, radios, and mobile data terminals.

The term for the original contract was for April 1, 2015 through June 30, 2018 with two additional one-year renewal options. Change Order 1 will extend the contract with Industrial Communications under the same terms and conditions for an additional year from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.
