Project Scope: HVAC system upgrade and Portico terrazzo repairs

- Current Status: Construction closure effective January 13
- Schedule impact due to asbestos abatement issue and contractor delays
- Abatement process completed; contractor work continues
- Construction work begun May 11 and HVAC in progress; not yet functional, so building is not temperature controlled, estimated completion of work July 8
- Contact-free public service, provided out of building annex, initiated June 16
- Communication plan implemented to keep all stakeholders informed of project progress
- Playground area temporarily closed per city guidelines
- Flag Pole installation completed
- Loggia terrazzo replacement has been placed on hold until gap funding can be identified

Project Scope: Scope: Upgrade room finishes (paint, window shades), state-of-the-art A/V system; improved Wi-Fi capacity and other technology improvements

Current Status: Job Order Contractor has completed original scope of work

- Current Status: All construction work has been completed
- Training on new audio/visual equipment will be scheduled after library returns to regular service

Igo Branch Library Renovation and Furniture Replacement

- Main furniture purchase (Steelcase) delayed due to manufacturer plant closure (due to Covid-19); installation scheduled for July 2020 (public service impact unexpected)
- Additional scope for new HVAC unit (in staff area which recently failed) has been approved and is currently in
 procurement process; work to be completed as soon as possible
