

ORDINANCE 2020-06-25-0448

RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION, AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS, FOR UP TO \$275,000.00 FROM THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, FOR THE TK20-FY20 DNA TESTING GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division has grant funds in an amount up to \$275,000.00 available to assist the San Antonio Police Department (SAPD), for reimbursing the costs associated with DNA kits collected from sexual assault/sexual offense offenders and submitted to the Bexar County Criminal Investigation Laboratory for analysis and testing; and

WHEREAS, SAPD submitted the grant application on February 3, 2020 and received notice that the grant was awarded on April 22, 2020, for kits submitted for testing from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this grant does not require an in-kind or cash match; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. The grant application is hereby ratified, and the City Manager and designee, and the Chief of Police for the City of San Antonio and designee, are hereby authorized to accept grant funds in the amount up to \$275,000.00 from the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office, Criminal Justice Division for the TK-20-FY20 DNA Testing Grant Program for reimbursement of expenditures incurred during the grant period of October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020.

SECTION 2. Upon acceptance of this award, new funds and internal order numbers will be created, upon which the award amount will be appropriated from the Office of the Governor. A final budget, which will include SAP Internal Orders and SAP GL Accounts, will be submitted by the SAPD upon award.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific SAP Fund Numbers, SAP Project Definitions, SAP WBS Elements, SAP Internal Orders, SAP Fund Centers, SAP Cost Centers, SAP Functional Areas, SAP Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and SAP GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
