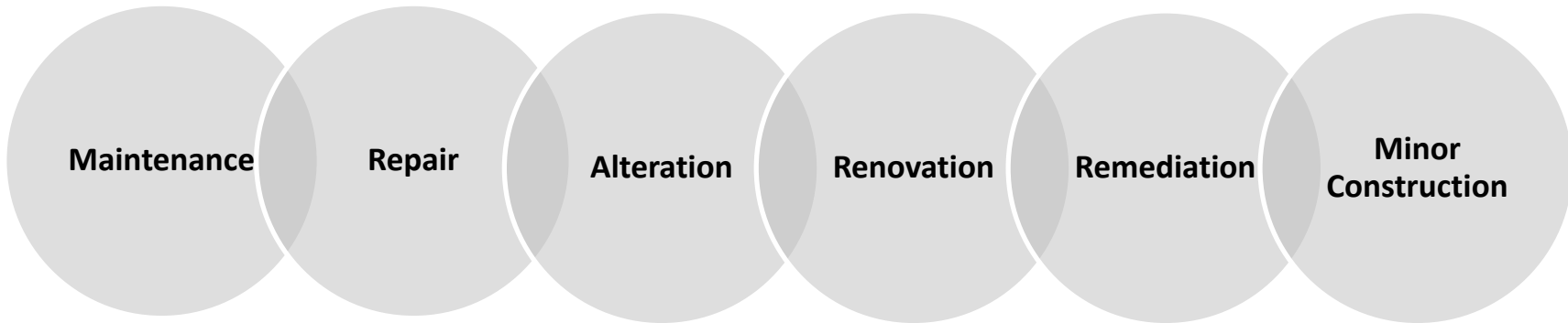

JOC Overview



Job Order Contracting (JOC) **applies only to a facility** for the following activities:



Governed by State Government Code Chapter 2269



JOC Overview



Key Components:

- Work is of a Recurring Nature
- Delivery times, type and quantities of work are indefinite
- Established Price
- Competitive Solicitation Process
- Allows for Multiple Contract Awards
- Payment and Performance Bonds based on amount of job order

Current JOC contracts expire on February 28, 2021

Request for Competitive Sealed Proposal (RFCSP) to be released September 2020

Evaluation Committee Composition to include External Committee Members

Review of Contractor's Past Performance based upon Scorecard

Respondent's experience related to JOC work performed and managed as part of evaluation review



Upcoming Solicitation

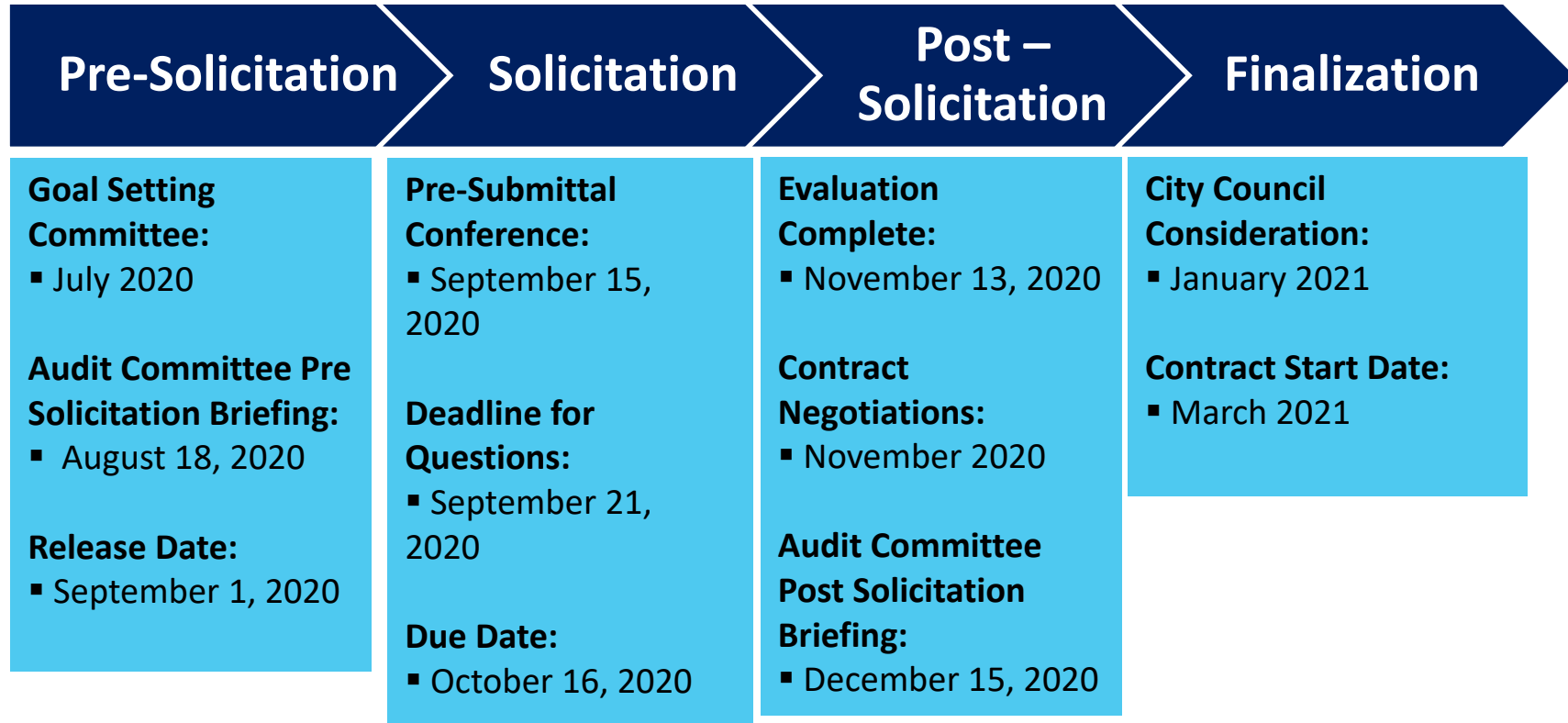


Proposed Evaluation Criteria:

- Respondent Experience including subcontractors and/or key personnel with similar Job Order Contracting Projects
- Understanding of JOC Program and Proposed Management Plan
- Respondent's experience with San Antonio Region Issues and Past Experience with City of San Antonio contracts
- Coefficient Price Proposal
- SBEDA Prime Contractor Program
