A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZES AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH NORTHSIDE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR AN EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission is tasked with the review and recommendation for acquisition of property for city projects; and

WHEREAS, there is an opportunity for an acquisition of property between the Northside Independent School District and the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the proposed property exchange will be considered on August 25 by the Northside Independent School District Board of Directors to acquire Meadowcliff Community Center for the enhancement of community offerings and donate, to the City of San Antonio, approximately 4.231 acres for greenway trail open space in Council District 6; and

WHEREAS, Northside Independent School District will make available the school or community center building so the City may continue to offer summer programming including camps and the summer food program; and

WHEREAS, Northside Independent School District will offer after school programming and open the school or community center building for the annual City Council District 6 backpack giveaway for the community; and

WHEREAS, this project is consistent with the goals and objectives outlined in the SA Parks System Plan which recommends providing equitable access to parks as well as the master plan for the Anson Jones Middle School; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department consistently looks for opportunities to collaborate with potential partners to establish public green space and provide recreational opportunities to meet the needs of the community; and

NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Recommend the City of San Antonio City Council authorize an interlocal agreement with Northside Independent School District.
