ORDINANCE

APPROVING TWO AGREEMENTS WITH PARENT/CHILD INCORPORATED WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW WHICH WILL PROVIDE A CUMULATIVE AMOUNT OF UP TO \$97,920.00 INCLUSIVE OF RENEWALS TO THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT'S ORAL HEALTH PROGRAM FOR THE PROVISION OF ORAL HEALTH SERVICES TO CHILDREN ENROLLED IN HEAD START PROGRAMS WITH TERMS ENDING AUGUST 31, 2021 AND SEPTEMBER 30, 2021.

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WHEREAS, the Head Start program is a federally-funded program that provides education, child development, nutrition, social services, health and disability assessments, and parent involvement, on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, the Early Head Start program is a federally-funded program that provides child care, education, child development, nutrition and social services, health and disability assessment and parent involvement, on a full-time basis; and

WHEREAS, families utilizing the programs and services do not have the financial resources to obtain such health evaluation services through the private medical community; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's (Metro Health) Oral Health Program is currently contracted to provide dental services for 4,852 children enrolled in Head Start and Early Head Start Programs; and

WHEREAS, in these programs, each enrollee is provided with an on-site limited oral health evaluation performed by a Metro Health dentist; and

WHEREAS, in addition, Metro Health dental staff provides case management services and support for all children identified with "urgent" or unmet dental needs who are uninsured or underinsured for required dental care; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance will authorize agreements with Parent/Child Incorporated allowing Metro Health to provide oral health services for infants and children enrolled in the Head Start and Early Head Start Programs; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee or the Director of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District or designee is authorized to execute two agreements with Parent/Child Incorporated

with options to renew which will provide a cumulative amount of up to \$97,920.00 inclusive of renewals to the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Oral Health Program for the provision of oral health services to children enrolled in Head Start programs with terms ending August 31, 2021 and September 30, 2021. The agreements in substantially final form are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment I and II**.

SECTION 2. [FINANCIAL LANGUAGE PENDING]

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Cost Centers, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, General Ledger Accounts, and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
