ORDINANCE

**AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ASD
CONSULTANTS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,254,979.50
FOR THE SAN PEDRO SPRINGS PARK PROJECT.**

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WHEREAS, in May 2017 voters approved the 2017 Bond Program which authorized \$1,800,000.00 for improvements to the San Pedro Springs Park located in Council District 1; and

WHEREAS, this project will provide for general park improvements to include the removal of the existing softball fields, construction of a new walking trail equipped with pedestrian lighting and benches, parking modifications, lighting and electrical upgrades, new sidewalks, historic acequia repairs, accessibility modifications, landscaping and irrigation, and the installation of a sign monument on the corner of San Pedro Avenue and Myrtle Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City advertised for construction bids in April 2020 and received and opened three bids on May 19, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance awards a construction contract to ASD Consultants, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,119,347.00 for the San Pedro Springs Park project; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The lowest responsive bid by ASD Consultants, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,119,347.00 for the San Pedro Springs Park project, is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, insurance certificates and endorsements.

SECTION 2. Payment is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to ASD Consultants, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$1,119,347.00. Payment is in support of the San Pedro Springs Park Project, using Fund 45099000, with the WBS Element 23-01704-05-02-01 and GL Account 5201140. Funding is provided by General Obligation Bonds and is in the FY2020-FY2025 CIP Budget.

Payment is limited to the amounts budgeted in the Operating and/or Capital Budget funding sources identified. All expenditures will comply with approved operating and/or capital budgets for current and future fiscal years.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Deputy Chief Financial Officer, City of San Antonio. The Deputy Chief Financial Officer may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to

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specific Fund Numbers, Project Definitions, WBS Elements, Internal Orders, Fund Centers, Cost Centers, Functional Areas, Funds Reservation Document Numbers, and GL Accounts as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon the receipt of eight affirmative votes; otherwise, it is effective ten days after passage.
