




Headwaters Ranch and Storrs Ranch

Headwaters Ranch

- > ~860 Acres near Tarpley in Bandera County
- Contains headwaters for Hondo Creek and Pigeon Roost Creek; located in Hondo Creek and Seco Creek watersheds
- ➤ Located approx. 5 miles north of current Area of Interest
- > EAA ranked high water quantity and very high water quality
- Requesting Stage 1-B Consideration (Appraisal)

Storrs Ranch

- Adjacent owners of up to 1,200 acres (Storrs family) also interested in the Program
- > Requesting Stage 1-A Consideration (Geological Assessment)
