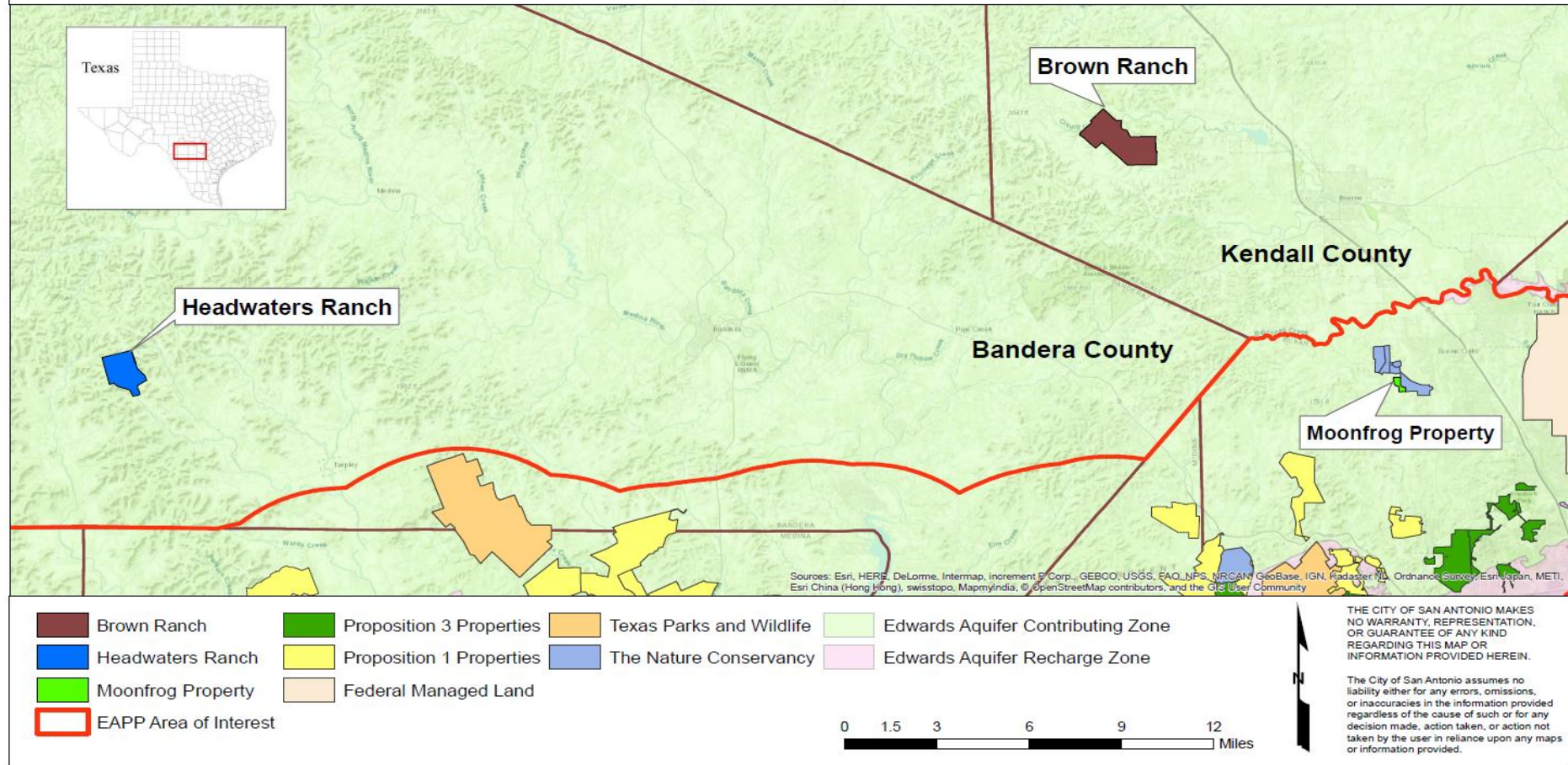

Headwaters Ranch (860 Acres) and Storrs Ranch (1,200 Acres) Bandera County

Headwaters Ranch

- ~860 Acres near Tarpley in Bandera County
- Contains headwaters for Hondo Creek and Pigeon Roost Creek; located in Hondo Creek and Seco Creek watersheds
- Located approx. 5 miles north of current Area of Interest
- EAA ranked high water quantity and very high water quality
- **Requesting Stage 1-B Consideration (Appraisal)**

Storrs Ranch

- Adjacent owners of up to 1,200 acres (Storrs family) also interested in the Program
- **Requesting Stage 1-A Consideration (Geological Assessment)**
