## ORDINANCE

## CONFIRMING THE TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF FORMER COUNCILMAN RAY LOPEZ AS THE VOTING ALTERNATE FOR COUNCILWOMAN ANA SANDOVAL FOR THE AUGUST 24, 2020 ALAMO AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TRANSPORTATION POLICY BOARD MEETING.

**WHEREAS**, the City has four elected-official and two staff positions on the Metropolitan Planning Organization Transportation Policy Board, which scheduled a meeting to adopt its budget on Monday, August 24, 2020, at the same time as the City Council Governance Committee meeting, creating a challenge for District 7 City Councilwoman Ana Sandoval, as she is a member of both bodies; and

WHEREAS, the bylaws of the AAMPO TPB permit the governing body to temporarily appoint a former City Council member to attend its meetings as a full participant in the event a City Council member is unable to attend, thereby ensuring the City is well-represented at the meeting; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to confirm the temporary appointment of former Councilman Ray Lopez as the voting alternate for Councilwoman Ana Sandoval at the August 24<sup>th</sup> AAMPO TPB meeting; NOW THEREFORE:

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

**SECTION 1**. The temporary appointment of former City Councilman Ray Lopez as the voting alternate for Councilwoman Ana Sandoval at the August 24<sup>th</sup> AAMPO TPB meeting is approved and confirmed.

**SECTION 2**. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon receipt of eight affirmative votes, otherwise it is effective ten days after passage.
